NEW high performance production cruiser-racer OOD

CONCEPT

The new Hunter HB 31 is designed with four basic aims in view:— To have a large degree of cruising comfort; to be aesthetically pleasing; to be fully competitive in open and club racing; and to be the FIRST high performance One Design of her size.

HULL

HB 31's hull form gives considerable internal volume. The lines are developed from the highly successful 'Luv' design to give the same magical combination of balance, control and speed. This is just as desirable to the cruising owner as it is to the racer. The hull is moulded using the latest and best Kevlar materials to produce an amazingly tough and stiff laminate whilst keeping weight low. We do not subscribe to the term 'exotic' materials. A top quality Kevlar laminate is superior to an all rovings laminate; just as an all rovings laminate became superior to chopped strand layup back in the '70's. Quite simply the HB 31 uses the latest and the best.

KEEL

The HB 31 has an all lead fin keel. This ensures the highest possible stability and lift and the lowest possible drag. On a yacht of this size and quality, a cast iron keel is quite simply 'second best' and a false economy.

ACCOMMODATION

The interior layout is designed to give space and comfort to the seagoing crew. Pokey aft cabins and clever gimmicks are all very well at Boat Shows; but NOT on yachts designed to leave the mooring and go sailing. There is a large galley aft to port complete with cooker and oven. sink, ice box and ample stowage. Aft to starboard there is a large navigation area plus navigators quarter berth. In the saloon there are two fixed pilot berths outboard of the comfortable settee berths. All have lee cloths. The structures are all teak faced wood and glassed into the hull whilst still in the mould. This ensures uniformity of snape and massive strength from the permanent box sections that result. You will never achieve the same strength with GRP moulded interior

hinging backrests. Foreward are conventional heads compartment with wash basin, hanging locker and a full sized double berth in the forecabin. Ventilation is supplied by three ventilators plus a mid saloon hatch, forehatch and aft companionway hatch. In short, the accommodation is civilised, comfortable and designed to work both in port and at sea.

DECK & COCKPIT

The visually attractive and efficient Hunter lines are much in evidence. The side decks are wide. The cockpit is long and comfortable. Primary two speed winches are mounted on forward turrets. All control lines lead aft via rope clutches. There is an anchor well for'd and cockpit locker aft.

RIG

The HB 31 has a fractional rig with single spreaders swept slightly aft. Simple single runners are supplied to give the keen racing owner maximum forestay tension upwind and maximum security when planing downwing under spinnaker. So the rig combines the ability to cruise simply or race efficiently . . . without resorting to the complications and hazards of multiple spreaders and miles of wire and string. Mainsail, No. 1 Genoa (MYLAR), 'Solent' Genoa, storm jib and Triradial spinnaker are all STANDARD.

MOTOR

Lightweight diesel inboard with geared folding propeller.

RACING

The IOR rating is anticipated to be around 21.7. Very competitive for a yacht of this size and pedigree. Strict One Design rules will be adhered to in the construction of the yacht. There is a genuine need for a top level One Design of around Half Ton Rating with a civilised interior. A Production 'Half Ton One Design' to give superb long term competition plus 'GT' cruising capability. A new Hunter is always exciting . . . and this one is no exception.

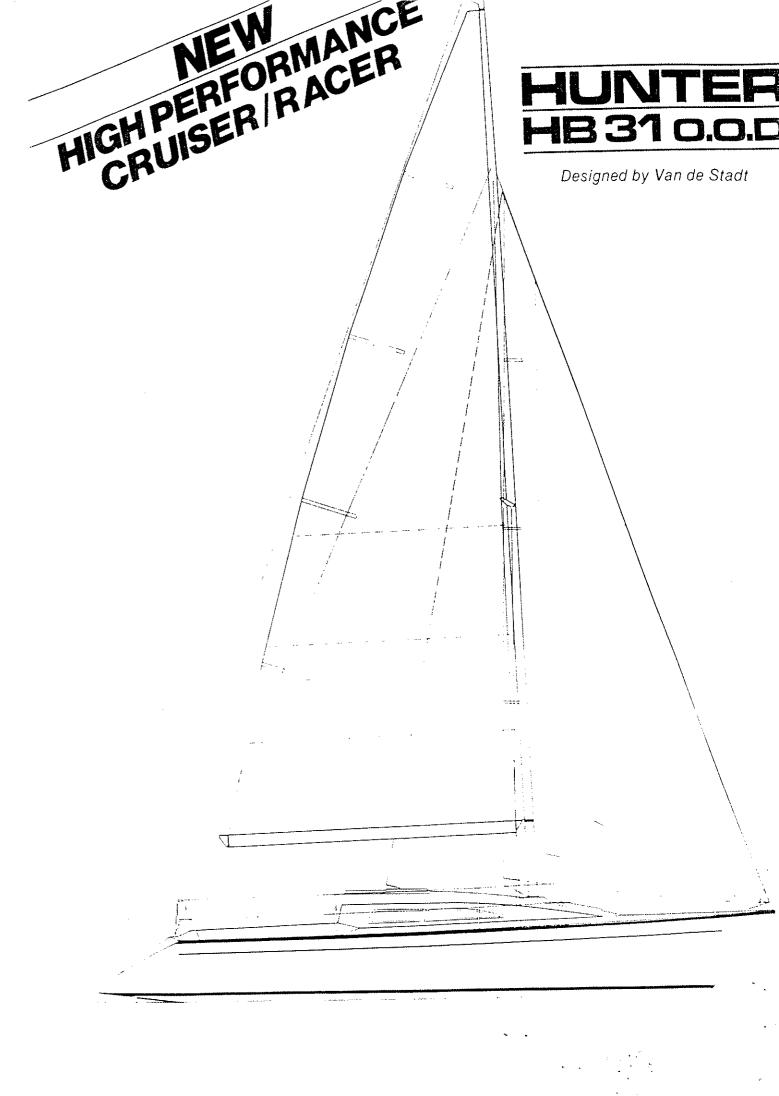

The HB31 Cruiser Racers have been going afloat and winning races as the 1983 season has progressed. Consistent Class wins and placings in such important series as the Solent Points and J.O.G. prove the point.

Indeed, at the moment, an HB 31 Cruiser Racer is currently top Half Tonner in both of these series. And it pays to remember that these results have been achieved against the fastest and most stripped out specials in the land. By amateur crews. And with just the standard sail wardrobe. All the HB 31s have sailed with just one all purpose No.1 Genoa for example. No lightweight specials or drifters. Which have often been necessary this year.

The principal results include the following:

Two 1sts, one 2nd, one 3rd and one 4th

J.O.G. (offshore)

Three 1sts, two 2nds

Royal Yorkshire YC Royal Southampton

So far no boats have been delivered to Scotland, Ireland or Wales. The first boats to do East Anglian events will be competing in 1984. But you can be sure that they will be winning there next year.

For interest, two of the successful South Coast HB 31 cruiser racers have also done long cruises. One to South Britanny with a husband/wife/three children crew. And another all around the West Country with a husband/wife/3yr.old sprog crew. Just to prove the superb dual purpose nature of the boat.

But, having said all this, several customers have asked us for a "souped up" version of the HB 31. For serious campaign on the International Half Ton circuit.

Many people noticed how a German yacht called "Olessa" dominated the three quarter ton class in Cowes Week 1983. She walked all over the latest UK one off and production three quarter tonners.

In fact "Olessa" is a DB2. A modified DB1 with new stern shape (same lines as the HB 31), taller lighter rig and amidships situated engine. So Van de Stadt have done the same exercise on the HB 31 to produce the HB31RS. Her main features are as follows:

- (1) Taller mast in a lighter section with double spreaders, checkstays etc.
- (2) Engine located amidships. This inevitably spoils the accommodation but aces give a slight benefit in weight distribution.
- (3) Lighter and simpler accommodation with less trim and fewer creature comforts.
- (4) Open transom with twin runner winches mounted athwartships aft plints.

The HB 31 RS version will be of particular interest to the kit builder and cedicated racer who wants to win at the lowest possible expense; in the hottest international company. The standard 31 Cruiser Racer is already winning comfortably. So it should not be difficult.

HULL. Kevlar composite laminates for maximum strength and stiffness combined with efficient weight distribution.

DECK. Cored Kevlar composite. Stiffeners & backing pads moulded in

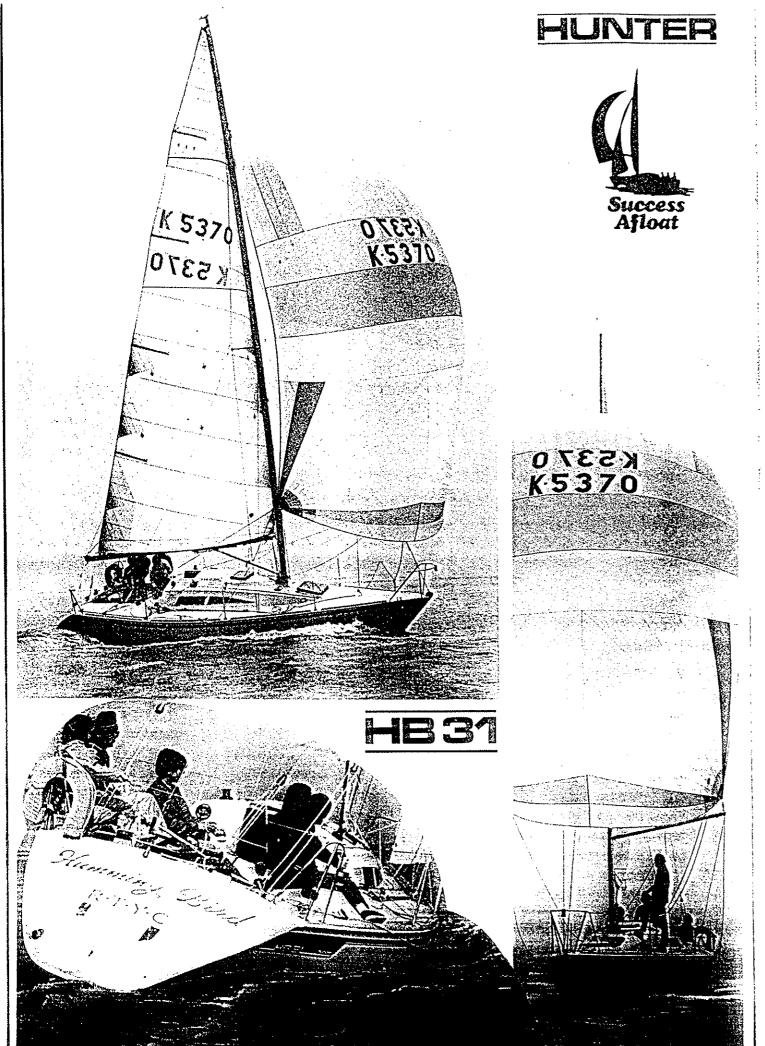
